# **DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION NO. 2023-00008**

<u>Location</u>: This approximately 8.25-acre property is located at **1215 Van Buren Street**, at the northwest corner of Coronado Street and Van Buren Street.

**Request:** The applicant requests approval of a conditional use permit to construct a Telecommunications Antenna taller than permitted by the Zoning Code. This request includes the demolition of an existing 60-foot monopole and the installation of a new 72-foot monoeucalyptus and associated ground-mounted equipment.

# **DEVELOPMENT APPLICATION NO. 2024-00021**

<u>Location</u>: This approximately 1.86-acre property is located at **1000 East Cerritos Avenue**, approximately 200 feet east of Lewis Street.

**Request:** The applicant requests to modify Conditional Use Permit No. 3509 to allow the sale of alcoholic beverages (Type 41 – On-Sale Beer and Wine – Eating Place) for on-premise consumption within an existing ice-skating rink facility.

Environmental Determination: The Planning Commission will consider whether to find the project Categorically Exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, Class 1 (Existing Facilities).
