Hoover Dam

The Boulder Canyon Project (Hoover Dam) consists of 17 hydroelectric generating units located approximately 25 miles from Las Vegas, Nevada. Fortysix (46) participants within the states of AZ, CA and NV participate in the Hoover Dam project. Southern California Public Power Authority members have obtained entitlements totaling 665 MW (32% of the Plant Capacity, of which Anaheim has 1.9477%) through Power Sales Agreements with SCPPA.

The new Electric Service Contract commenced upon expiration of the previous Agreement on October 31, 2017, and it expires on September 30, 2067.
