



Center City Corridors Specific Plan

Center City is the thriving civic, cultural, and community heart of Anaheim, building on a rich history and sense of place while providing a variety of opportunities for residents, businesses, and visitors alike.

Overview

The Anaheim Center City Corridors Specific Plan (C3SP) will provide a vision for the future of the Center City Corridors area and contain guiding principles and themes to inform the evolution of the Study Area over time.

The C3SP study area is comprised of approximately 2,600 acres and is centrally located within the City of Anaheim. The C3SP area boundaries are the SR-91 Freeway to the north, Interstate 5 and Platinum Triangle to the south, East Street and the Metrolink Railroad to the east, and Interstate 5 and West Street to the west.

The C3SP process began in 2019 with a grant from the Southern California Association of Governments to prepare a Vision Plan. The Vision Plan incorporated substantial community engagement and input and was finalized in April 2020. Preparation of the Specific Plan is funded by Caltrans and will be used to establish more detailed policies and guidance for future land use, placemaking, mobility, community services and amenities, and infrastructure decisions.

The C3 Specific Plan process will be an approximately 18-month effort and will include expanded community engagement, stakeholder involvement and technical analyses.
