#### Project Facts

- 0.5-Mile Stretch, High Pedestrian Use
- Vital Connection to I-5 and Downtown
- High Collision Rates
- Traffic Congestion with Bottleneck Conditions

#### Project Features

- Add West and East Bound Lane, Dedicated Right Turn onto Harbor Boulevard
- Full Width Sidewalk and Parkway, ADA Compliant Curb Ramps
- Raised Landscape Median, Reducing Left Turn Conflicts



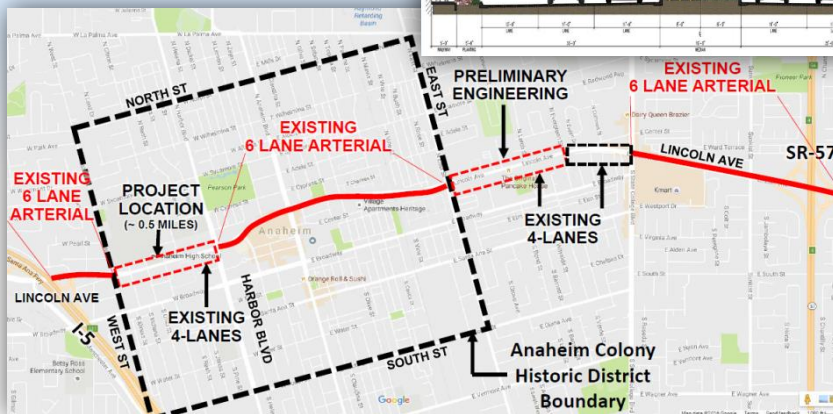
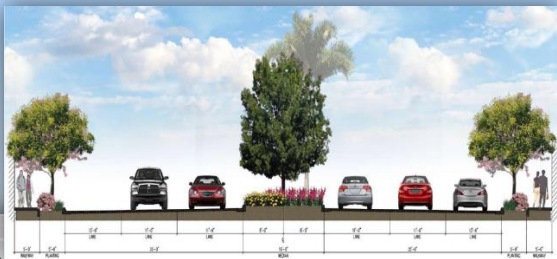
#### Project Goals

- Improve Pedestrian Safety and Mobility
- Reduce Traffic Collisions
- Relieve Traffic Congestion and Neighborhood Cut Through Traffic – Remove Bottleneck Conditions
- Maintain School Zone Speed Limit – 25 MPH
- Minimize Private Property Impacts, Collaborative Solutions



#### Estimated Costs

- Engineering and Environmental : \$700,000 (funded)
- Right of Way : \$13,500,000 (funded)
- Construction: \$6,000,000 (unfunded)
- Total: \$20,200,000
