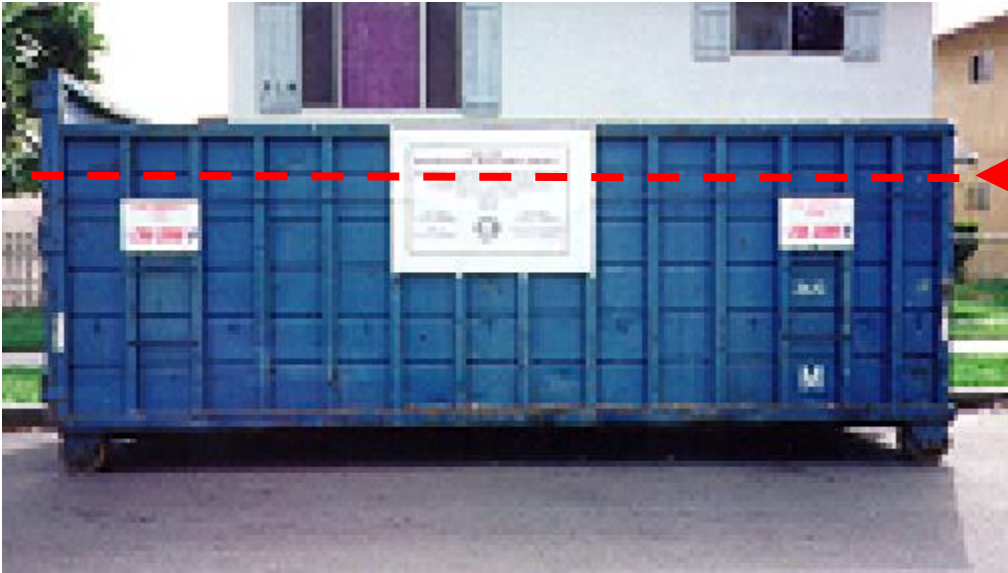




CITY OF ANAHEIM Neighborhood Cleanup Program Bin Guidelines

Bins must not reach “overflow” capacity. Please ensure that the bin is not filled past the line in the photo below. If bins overflow you may be responsible for extra charges.



DO NOT DISPOSE OF THE FOLLOWING HAZARDOUS MATERIALS IN ANY TRASH BINS:

- Automotive products (antifreeze, motor oil, fluids)
- Batteries (home and car)
- Computers
- Cosmetics
- Fluorescent light tubes and ballasts
- Fuels
- Herbicides
- Hobby supplies
- Household cleaners
- Medicines
- Mercury (thermometers, thermostats)
- Paint products
- Paints (latex and oil)
- Personal care products
- Pesticides
- Polishes and waxes
- Pool and spa chemicals
- Propane tanks from barbecues
- Televisions
- Unused road flares
- Wood preservative
